

CONSTRUCTION OF NON-MOTORISED TRANSPORT FACILITIES IN THE CAPE TOWN CBD

The City of Cape Town hereby informs the public of the construction of new and the rehabilitation of existing non-motorised transport (NMT) facilities in the Cape Town CBD, aimed at improving pedestrian infrastructure and safety and focusing on universal access for the disabled.

The work is scheduled to start on 1 August 2020 and will last for 24 months. Construction work will take place between 07:00 am and 17:30 on weekdays. On request the contractor may work outside normal working hours.

Please note that:

- Dates may change due to unforeseen circumstances;
- Traffic moving in both directions will be affected;
- Flag personnel will regulate traffic in one direction at a time through a stop-and-go system;
- Work areas will be demarcated to regulate traffic flow as well as pedestrians;
- Vehicles parked on the roadway and obstructing the maintenance work will be moved or towed away.

No congestion is expected but it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.
