DRAFT CITY OF CAPE TOWN: CITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BY-LAW AND CITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT POLICY

The City of Cape Town intends to amend and rename the City of Cape Town: Special Rating Area By-law 2012, Special Rating Area Amendment By-law 2016 and Special Rating Area Policy 2017 as the City Improvement District By-law and City Improvement District Policy, respectively. In so doing, the City seeks to create an enabling environment which allows a community to initiate, drive and fund the establishment of a CID in its area under the guidance and oversight of the City of Cape Town.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input on the draft amendments to the municipality from 16 August 2021 to 15 September 2021.
