




The above graph reflects the total reported incidents per month since July 2021.

For the period, 1-31 July 2023 there were 47 incidents reported.

July 2023

Thefts recorded the highest number of incidents (25) broken down as follows –theft out of motor vehicle (4), general theft (13), attempted theft of motor vehicle (3), attempted theft out of motor vehicle (2), theft of car parts (1), theft of bicycle (2).

Other reported crimes were robberies / muggings (8), business robbery (1), burglary (5), attempted burglary (2), malicious damage to property (4), assault gbh (1) and trespass (1).

Proactive engagement (e.g. reports of suspicious activity / persons / vehicles) from the community went slightly less compared to the previous month (36 reports, 4 less received by the Control Room during June 2023).

The OBSID public safety team have to inform owners or residents of unlocked vehicles, open doors, and open garages or premises gates. OBSID's public safety team recorded 283 proactive incidents this month.




INCIDENTS V. PROACTIVE ACTIONS BY THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS:

- 29 July 2023 Alfred Street, general theft


TOTAL INCIDENTS BY CATEGORY AND MAP:




INCIDENTS OF CONCERN:

• Robbery (9) (muggings, robbery with a weapon other than a firearm and armed robbery);




SUMMARY OF ACTIVE PERIODS FOR THE MONTH:


Highest incident periods: (13) incidents were reported as occurring during the week (Monday to Thursday) and (32) incidents over the weekend (Friday to Sunday).

The high number of late reports makes it difficult to accurately determine when incidents occurred – however it appears as if the majority of incidents took place between 18h00 – 06h00.

INCIDENTS BY TIMES OF DAY (AS REPORTED):






 OBS Red 2, recorded 6 incidents (10) reported the previous month – 49 proactive actions had to be conducted in this area:



• Blue 1, recorded 10 incidents (5) reported the previous month – 16 proactive actions had to be conducted in this area:




 Blue 2, recorded 9 incidents (11) reported the previous month – 42 proactive actions had to be conducted in this area:




 Blue 3, recorded 5 incidents (3) reported the previous month – 22 proactive actions had to be conducted in this area:




 Orange recorded 4 incidents (6) reported the previous month – 64 proactive actions had to be conducted in this area:



• Yellow recorded 4 incidents (12) reported the previous month – 15 proactive actions had to be conducted in this area:




